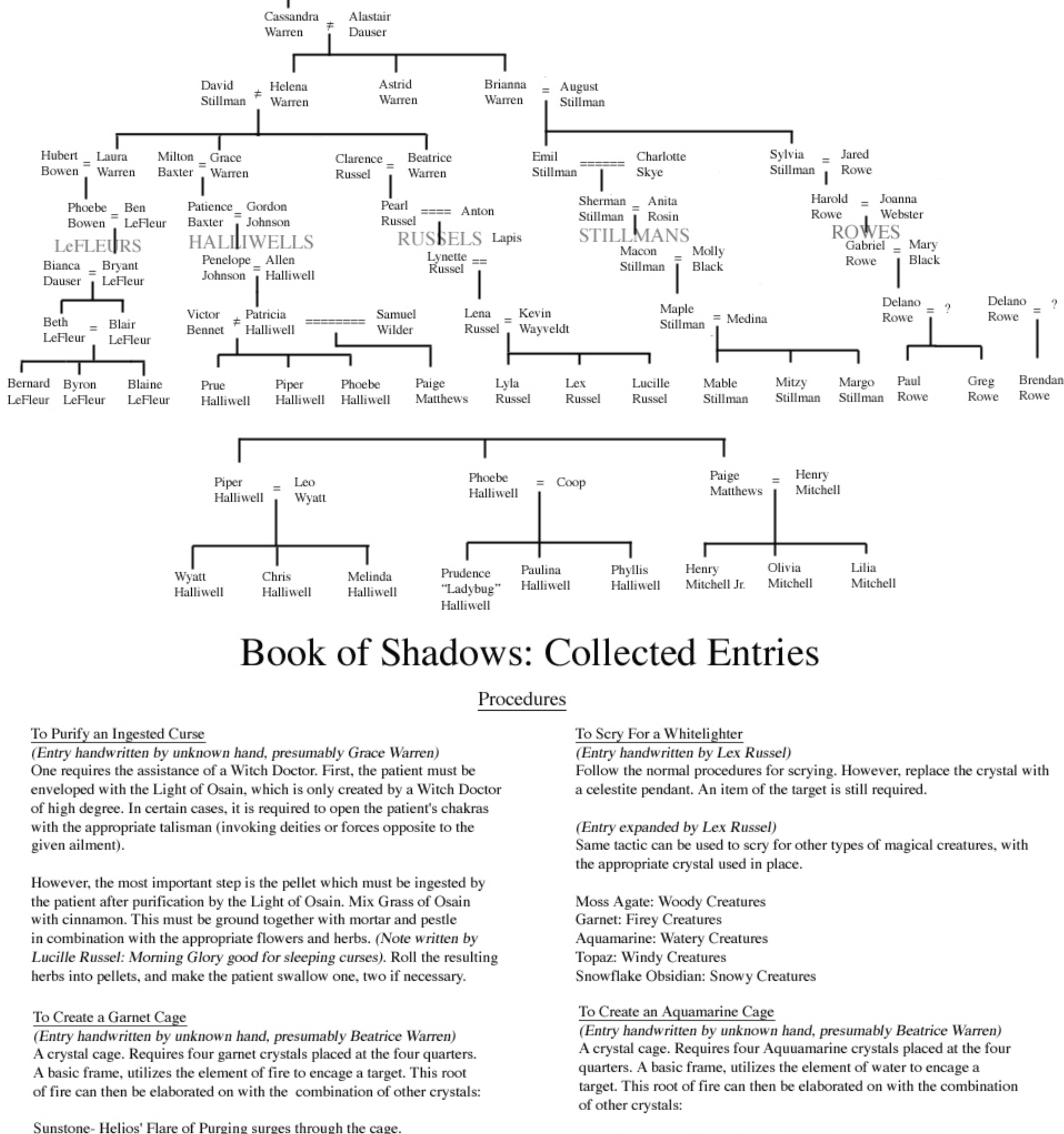


Charmed Reborn

Procedures

To Purify an Ingested Curse

(Entry handwritten by unknown hand, presumably Grace Warren)

One requires the assistance of a Witch Doctor. First, the patient must be enveloped with the Light of Osain, which is only created by a Witch Doctor of high degree. In certain cases, it is required to open the patient's chakras with the appropriate talisman (invoking deities or forces opposite to the given ailment).

However, the most important step is the pellet which must be ingested by the patient after purification by the Light of Osain. Mix Grass of Osain with cinnamon. This must be ground together with mortar and pestle in combination with the appropriate flowers and herbs. (Note written by Lucille Russel: Morning Glory good for sleeping curses). Roll the resulting herbs into pellets, and make the patient swallow one, two if necessary.

To Create a Garnet Cage

(Entry handwritten by unknown hand, presumably Beatrice Warren)

A crystal cage. Requires four garnet crystals placed at the four quarters. A basic frame, utilizes the element of fire to encage a target. This root of fire can then be elaborated on with the combination of other crystals:

Sunstone- Helios' Flare of Purging surges through the cage.

Fire Opal- Helios' Flare of Dazzling surges through the cage.

Rock crystal- Augments the strength of the cage, lining it with fire.

To Scry For a Whitelighter

(Entry handwritten by Lex Russel)

Follow the normal procedures for scrying. However, replace the crystal with a celestite pendant. An item of the target is still required.

(Entry expanded by Lex Russel)

Same tactic can be used to scry for other types of magical creatures, with the appropriate crystal used in place.

Moss Agate: Woody Creatures

Garnet: Firey Creatures

Aquamarine: Watery Creatures

Topaz: Windy Creatures

Snowflake Obsidian: Snowy Creatures

To Create an Aquamarine Cage

(Entry handwritten by unknown hand, presumably Beatrice Warren)

A crystal cage. Requires four Aquamarine crystals placed at the four quarters. A basic frame, utilizes the element of water to encage a target. This root of fire can then be elaborated on with the combination of other crystals:

Aqua Aura Quartz- Oceanus' Rain surges through the cage.

Lumuria Seed- Oceanus' Flood surges through the cage.

Rock Crystal- Augments the strength of the cage, freezing the cage with ice crystals.

Spells

To Summon a Spirit:

Light five white candles in a circle. Chant outside the circle:

Hear these words, hear my cry, spirit from the other side. Come to me, I summon thee. Cross now the great divide.

Vanishing Spell:

Let the object of objection become but a dream, as I cause the seen to be unseen. (Note written by Paige Matthews-Mitchell: Greatest spell ever!!!)

To Bless a Home:

(Entry Handwritten by Lyla Russel)

Requires the Power of Three (or more)

Evil cannot stand and fight in this hallowed place of light. By the will of the Power of Three, protect this place by land and sea.

To Awaken a Charmed One

(Entry Handwritten by Piper Halliwell)

Power three come into me. The Power of three will set you free

Allies & Enemies

Brianna Warren

(Entry Handwritten by unknown hand, presumably Laura, Grace, or Beatrice Warren)

Brianna was the oldest of her sisters, who mastered the gift of telekinesis. She resided in Crimea, Ukraine, during the Crimean War, where she helped fight the demonic Lords of War. Her greatest conquest was when she separated Lord Gabrielle from his crystal sword, by using her telekinesis to throw it hundreds of miles away. She married the aristocrat August Stillman, and had two children: Emil and Sylvia. Unfortunately, upon the deaths of Brianna and August, their whereabouts are unknown.

Astrid Warren

(Entry Handwritten by unknown hand, presumably Laura, Grace, or Beatrice Warren)

Astrid was the middle of her sisters, who mastered the gift of molecular immobilization. She resided in Japan, and was present when Matthew Perry attempted to open Japan to foreign trade. Astrid and the coven she joined attempted to defend Edo from the military ships Perry sent out, but their attempt failed due to an as-of-yet unknown magical party that Perry brought along himself. Astrid, unlike her two sisters, did not marry, remaining a bachelorette her whole life.

(Note written by Phoebe Halliwell: Not bachelorette! Her partner was a woman who lived in Japan; that's why she moved.)

Helena Warren

(Entry Handwritten by unknown hand, presumably Laura, Grace, or Beatrice Warren)

Helena was the youngest of her sisters, who mastered the gift of premonition. She arrived in San Francisco in lieu of the California Gold Rush, the only one of her sisters to have stayed on the American continent. Her power of foresight allowed her and her lover, David, to be far more successful than other miners, and by the time the Elders stopped her for personal gain, she was rich enough to settle down permanently. Personal Gain later struck back, killing David.

The Stillman Brothers

(Entry Handwritten by Phoebe Halliwell)

August and David Stillman were two brothers who also descended from a long tradition of witchcraft. They both accompanied Helena Warren on her journey West, and David fell in love with Helena. When the three of them grew rich from the Gold Rush, Helena was visited by her sister, Brianna, after the subsiding of the Crimean War. Brianna and August eloped, and settled down in America as well. David was later killed from backfired personal gain, leaving Helena with her three daughters, and August later died of natural causes.

(Note written by Phoebe Halliwell: Related to Stillman Sisters??? Will research further, tie in to family tree.)

Laura Warren

(Entry Handwritten by Penelope Johnson)

Laura wielded the power of aerokinesis. Raised as a demon hunter by her mother, Helena, who was outraged after the death of her husband. Laura was a master of potions, and wrote many of the potion formulas in this book. She, like her sisters, married a witch: Hubert Bowen. Their daughter, Phoebe, was raised by her aunt Grace after both Laura and Hubert died by demonic hand.

Beatrice Warren

(Entry Handwritten by Penelope Johnson)

Beatrice was the sister of Laura and Grace, who wielded the power of psychometry. Frail yet beautiful compared to her sisters, Beatrice did not fare as well with the training Helena pushed upon her. The work became so dangerous that Beatrice lost a leg. As a result, Beatrice was further confined to research in the magical arts. Beatrice was the first to discover and utilize crystal cages. She married the witch Clarence; they lived happily together with their daughter, Pearl. However, both she and Clarence died; presumably by demon attack, but the true cause is unknown. Pearl, along with her cousin, Phoebe, who was similarly orphaned, were raised by their aunt Grace.

Grace Warren

(Entry Handwritten by Penelope Johnson)

Grace wielded the power of teleportation. More adventurous than both her sisters, Grace used her power to travel around the world; she particularly enjoyed venturing to China, where she apprenticed in Taoist Magic, and Nigeria, where she learned arcane arts of Yoruba Witch Doctors. However, after the deaths of both her sisters and their lovers, Grace's travels were cut short as she was forced to settle down in San Francisco to raise her nieces. She married the witch Milton Baxter, and raised her daughter, Patience, with her cousins as if they were sisters.

Phoebe Bowen, Pearl Russel, Emil Stillman, Sylvia Stillman

(Entries Handwritten by Phoebe Halliwell)

Lucy: Hey Lyla. Can I see these entries?

Lyla: Which ones?

Lucy: Umm... Phoebe Bowen, Pearl Russel, Emil-

Lyla: No. Don't even touch them.

Lucy: Lemme read them!

Lyla: I helped write them, I get to tell you when you can read them.

Lucy: Ly, you're such a bully! Lemme-- *garh!* --I wanna see!

Lyla: No!

Oni

(Entry handwritten by unknown hand, but presumably Astrid Warren)

Oni are goblin-like demons that spread bad luck. The most common demon in Japan besides tengu. Oni normally pose very little threat and can be repelled with proper charms by a priest or priestess. However, Oni also come in a very wide variety; some variations are particularly more savage, taking pleasure in devouring their victims. Note that Oni can never enter a household unless invited.

(Entry expanded by Lucille Russel)

Oni have the ability to shapeshift, with the assistance of skins made of paper. This paper skin can be unfolded and painted to perfectly impersonate any appearance. The paper skin is also impervious to most forms of magic, including whitelighter arrows. Try to burn or cut it off.

Dragon Warlocks

Perhaps the most feared and powerful witch killer there is. Fear his flight, fear his fire, the strength of a hundred men. Lineage: the twisted spawn of a dragon and sorceress. Beware: Only the most powerful dare challenge.

(Entry expanded by Piper Halliwell)

Additional powers vary depending on the abilities of their descendant dragons and sorcerers; salamanders, leviathans, and even ryus have been known to consort with warlocks, and as a result are possible donors of Dragon Warlock powers. Although some dragons are benevolent creatures, However mighty the Dragon Warlock is, he can be defeated with the basic Power of Three spell.

(Note written by Prudence Halliwell, although the penmanship seems immature: Dragon Warlocks are totally hawt!!!!)

Ryus

(Entry handwritten by unknown hand, but presumably Astrid Warren)

Ryus, water dragons, usually benevolent, with the power to control storms. When angered they attack with bolts of lightning. One of the most mysterious of dragons, said to live as much in this world as the dream world.

(Entry expanded by Lex Russel)

Ryus, along with the power of flight, can also manipulate fire, wind, water, and lightning. Ryus are heavily connected with the dream world; when they are awake in the dream world, they are asleep in the waking world. The dream world has different mechanics than the waking world; regular magic has no effect, but Ryus can effectively utilize their abilities as well as they can in the waking world.

The Elephant Man

(Entry discovered by Lucille Russel; the closest entry she could find to Lex Russel's description of his assailant)

A mysterious ally of good, also named the White Elephant by oral tradition. Oftentimes associated with the dream world, the Elephant Man visits dreams of exceptionally good people, consuming their nightmares and replacing them with pleasant sleep.

Creepier Demons

Demons that dwell in shadow, and prey on the souls of good beings. Can be summoned by the following spell: *Demons who dwell in slivers of night, unlock your shadows to witches' sight.* A creepier demon can be vanquished with a potion of vervain, nightshade, holly, and dried oak leaves.

(Entry expanded by unknown hand, scrawled and messy)

There was once a seamstress in a faraway land. Her daughter was the most beautiful girl in the village, and the seamstress grew obsessed with her daughter's beauty. As her daughter grew older, the seamstress feared that her beauty would fade away. In a bout of fear, the seamstress killed her daughter. She stitched her daughter's mouth shut, hoping that her spirit would never leave her body, and she would stay forever beautiful. The body of the daughter became filled with rage and hate which could not escape from the stitched shut mouth, and to this day, it is said she roams the earth as a mouthless demon, searching for the mother that abandoned her.

The Yuki-Onna

(Entry handwritten by unknown hand, but presumably Astrid Warren)

A figure in Japanese mythology. A beautiful young woman once died of a frozen heart in a blizzard, becoming the Yuki-Onna, the powerful spirit of snow. She wields the ability to control and create snow, and she can turn invisible in a snow storm. To banish the Yuki-Onna, one must thaw her heart.

(Entry expanded by Lex Russel)

Once upon a time, a woman fell in love with a charming man. The man was so vain that he did not govern her entire feelings. He broke her heart. The woman ran out into the snow, and in order to cope with the sadness, she let ice coat her heart, and cold god her real being. She only wanted to hurt others, just like the man she loved hurt her. But now she knows that ice is not just a terrible thing. Snow is not only cold and harsh, but soft and delicate. Like love, it can hurt; but it can also be beautiful.

Amy

(Entry handwritten by Lyla Russel)

A powerful demon who is said to be the daughter of Zira. She is the leader of Zira's Sisterhood, an all-female demon organization that is adept in brutal en masse attacks. She has amazing strength, and the ability to erect a force-field of sorts that protects her from any harm. No known vanquish.

Kane (?)

(Entry Handwritten by Lucille Russel)

The most powerful darklighter in the Underworld, he is the leader of the Order of the Ebon Twilight, and a prominent member of the Seven. The Order is composed of darklighters, warlocks, and a manner of other dark assailants, and Kane himself is a master of espionage and psychological warfare. Common myth states Kane as old as Proteus himself, and as having converted more witches into warlocks than any other darklighter.

Biblies Barbatos

(Entry Handwritten by Lyla Russel)

The leader of the Libris, demons whose job it is to prevent the knowledge of demons from spreading. He and the Libris control a vast information archive of history and science, which they hoard completely to themselves. This enclave of books lets them lend an extra lift of knowledge to the Seven.

Chrysele Ipos

(Entry handwritten by Lyla Russel)

A demon who, with his assistants, can instantaneously receive visions and premonitions. He is the leader of Cassandra's Eyes, the demonic order of seers and oracles who collectively monitor the present, past, and future. He and his order tend to not participate in battle often, preferring to provide information to the rest of the Seven instead.

The Oracle Twins: Postverta and Antevorte

(Entry Handwritten by Lyla Russel)

Ipos is almost never seen without his attendants, Postverta and Antevorte. Twin oracles gifted with clairvoyance. Postverta monitors the past while her sister Antevorte predicts the future. Their pooled powers, coupled with Ipos' omniscience, allows Cassandra's Eyes to monitor the past, present, and future with ease.

(Note written by Piper Halliwell: One uses fire, one uses ice. But they're both pretentious assholes.)

The Seer

An upper-level demon who has been around for thousands of years. Because she has the power to see the future, she is a top advisor to the Source of all Evil. In fact, she has served multiple Sources, choosing to remain close to the ultimate power. She is a magical craftsman and master at spells and tonics, but only kills when she has to.

(Entry expanded by Piper Halliwell)

The first Seer was vanquished when she attempted to take the Source's child into herself, but could not handle the power. The second Seer, Kira, was vanquished by the demon Zankou after she gave vital information to the Charmed Ones regarding the Avatars. She was killed before she could be made human.

(Note written by Phoebe Halliwell: She was a great friend.)

The Continuum Wars

(Entry is worn and torn, barely noticable. Some excerpts are completely rubbed out.)

All ancient cultures...consistent myth...an eternal battle... Although variations appear, the light and dark...destined...and Twilight of... imminent. And yet the...begin the...unknown. A valid...is...to blame?

Trivia! (Rather hard...)

I thought this up a little bit last minute, figured it might be, err... "fun" :D. However, I believe they are a tad bit hard, and a lot of the references are really vague (gosh, I'm such a nerd! :O) and will probably require a little research on Google, Wikipedia, Youtube, etc. So as a result, here's what I'll do:

Get one right: I'll send you the list of musical artists I'm going to use for the subsequent episodes.

Get two right: I'll send you the actual list of episode numbers and musical artists for the rest of the season.
